- Used to rank applicants
- Distance
- Siblings
- Unique criteria (church affiliation

Registration:

- Open now
- Closes 31st October

Naming Schools:

- 4 choices + option to add reasons for choice (e.g. sibling)
- PLEASE NAME FOUR SCHOOLS
- Only name 2 or 3 and you don't rank highly enough for an offer of a place, the Local Authority will allocate you a school without additional choices on your list
- Keep control of your choice of school

Naming Schools:

- Be informed about the likelihood of you being offered a place
- **DISTANCE**
- ADDITIONAL ADMISSIONS
 CRITERIA
- Additional evidence required forms collected from the schools

National Offer Day

- Monday 2nd March
- Email sent after 4pm
- Log on from 5pm
- Offer letter sent by post first class
- Name given of the school you have been offered the place at

National Offer Day

- Happy? Accept the place, the school will then be in contact in the following few weeks
- Unhappy? Posted information contains waiting list paper work (also online)
- Waiting lists are for schools on your original list

Waiting Lists

- Unhappy with the school offered?
- ACCEPT THE PLACE BY 16th March
- Your child MUST hold a place in the school system
- Complete waiting list requests by 16th March

- Waiting Lists
 Up until 22nd April, the Local
 Authority will contact you if you are
 successful in gaining a place through
 a waiting list request
- After this date, the schools handle their own waiting lists
- If you receive a new offer, let the original school know

Waiting Lists

- Swings and Roundabouts reallocation of places through appeals and waiting lists
- Can take until July for waiting lists
- May be unsuccessful
- Accept the original school offered

Kent Test and Grammar

- Only applies if your child took the Kent Test.
- 17th October Kent Test results
- Indicates G for grammar, H for high school.
- With a G name grammar schools on your application form
- Submit, grammar place offered 2nd March
- You can submit waiting list request if you want another grammar to the one offered

Kent Test Parent Appeals

- H decision and intention to appeal
- Name grammar school as 1st choice and 3 high schools
- You'll be allocated a place at a high school
- ACCEPT THE PLACE YOUR CHILD MUST HAVE A SCHOOL PLACE FOR SEPTEMBER
- Naming a grammar at No.1 registers your belief that a grammar school is the most appropriate setting for your child
- (risk that it can seem you've decided to appeal because you got a high school you didn't want) Respect, Equality, Courage, Kindness

Kent Test Parent Appeals

- Submit the secondary application form online as usual by 31st October
- On National Offer day, the grammar appeal paperwork will be sent by post
- Complete and submit by 27th March
- Appeals held May/June
- Parents attend the panel to outline why grammar is the most suitable setting
- School helps with supporting evidence
 Respect, Equality, Courage, Kindness
