



Dear Parents and Carers,

As I'm sure you are aware, well-being activities are an important part of our curriculum at Chilton. We have daily activities such as yoga, brain gym, meditation and peer massage to give children mental and physical breaks from learning and to help them through transitions at different points of the day. We have now added '1k a day' to these activities. Children from Year 1 to 6 will have the opportunity to complete 1km around the field on a daily basis. We keep this timed quite strictly with an emphasis on working towards 1km per day and we also promote effort and fun over completing the whole distance. It is also never a competition with other children – it's a personal goal and children support each other in their efforts. So far, the children have been enjoying having a go at the distance each day. The initiative also supports our PSHE and PE curriculum and teaches children about being active and healthy lifestyles. Exercise is also so important for mental as well as physical health and the Change 4 Life campaign recommends that children are active for 60 minutes per day so we hope to contribute to that with playtimes and the 1k! Please chat to your child's class teacher to find out how it is incorporated in to different days in different year groups. Reception children will be joining in a little later in the year!
