We have been warned by a vigilant parent from one of our partner schools about a popular ipad game that some of our pupils play.

ROBLOX can contain unsuitable and inappropriate content as part of the chat feature. A conversation can be held between players and the content of this is not moderated. One way of trying to prevent access to inappropriate materials is to ensure that restrictions are enabled on devices like ipads and iphones. This can be found under Settings – General – Restrictions – Enable Restrictions.

At school we constantly and consistently teach children about staying safe on-line. We have a zero tolerance policy if misuse of the internet.

The last week of this term is an anti-bullying week focusing on cyber bullying and incorporating safer internet day on the 7th February. The school will once again be teaching children safe practices and what to do if something on the internet upsets or alarms them.
