



Dear Parents and Carers,

Our behaviour for learning systems are all built around rewards. Today, if your child has kept all of their points, they will have earned their gold badge. There is still opportunity to earn this badge in the remaining weeks!

Each 'seasonal' term, we hold bouncy castle / party sessions as a reward for the children's behaviour and class rewards continue throughout the year as they are earned. These can then be more personalised for the children's interests.

At the end of the year, we also run additional rewards for children's excellent behaviour. On Monday 22nd July, we have organised an 'inflatable fun day'. We have hired several inflatables and children who have kept 95% of their points (highly likely to be every child) will enjoy some time on these with their friends.

We have arranged very, very special events for children who have kept every single point this year. Reception and Year 1 children will have a trip to the park and children in Years 2-5 will be visiting the cinema. All of these events are funded by the school. I did want to point out that I am considering a different approach to this for next year in response to pupil and parent feedback.
