Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you enjoyed your half-term! We have had a great start to Term 4 and we are looking forward to the second half of the school year.

We monitor children's attendance weekly and will make contact when attendance is becoming a concern. This is not to be troublesome to families - it is our job to ensure that children are attending school when they can and are well enough to do so. I will be writing to families where attendance remains a concern and we do not have medical evidence to support repeated or extended absences. I would ask you all to work with the school to ensure that your children are attending when they can and that they are on time. Days missed cannot be re-taught and whilst teachers will provide recap for children who have missed learning it is a simple fact that the lessons have been lost. Similarly, I can only authorise holidays in exceptional circumstances.

The week preceding half term was online safety week and the children's online safety videos will be uploaded by Monday to blog pages (Supporting Learning tab on the website). There was a huge amount of attention in the media across half term on the appalling interactions and 'trolling' that goes on across social media platforms. The fact that children may be immersed in this kind of online culture concerns me greatly. We have a huge responsibility to protect our children from this kind of behaviour and to educate them on the effects of this behaviour so that they do not replicate it.

Chilton will be focusing on behaviour this term. A survey conducted by our Junior Leaders revealed that the children have a perception that some children 'get away' with bad behaviour. This is unacceptable and is something that I have asked the whole school to address. In particular, any issues with physical behaviour will be taken very seriously and we will make contact with parents on this matter. I hope that parents will support the leadership team and teachers in our approaches to ensuring that Chilton remains a happy and safe environment to all.

Of course, measures to proactively address poor behaviour can only be successful with the continued and consistent reward for excellent behaviour. Staff will continue to recognise and reward the vast majority of our children whose behaviour is exceptional. Which brings me on to mention the Chilton Super Heroes selected by class teachers for being truly amazing pupils across term 3.
