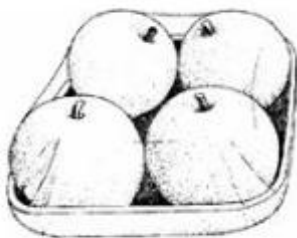
2) A set of desks costs £705. Mrs Rowland-Hill buys 4 sets for her school. She says the total cost is £2820.
