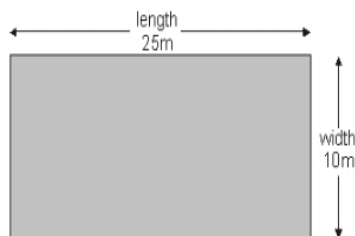
1) A box contains trays of melons. There are 15 melons in a tray. There are 11 trays in a box. How many melons are there?
