Judaism is one of the oldest religions in the world. It was started by a man called Abraham around the year 2,500 BC. Abraham is known as the Father of Judaism because his descendants were the people who were the first Jewish people.



Jewish population

- There are approximately 14 million Jewish people in the world.
- The country with the largest Jewish population is the United States of America.
- Israel is the only country where Judaism is the main religion.

The Holy Book

- The Jewish holy book is called the Torah.
- The Torah is written in a language called Hebrew.
- The Torah is often written on a scroll.



Worship

- Jews worship in a temple called a synagogue.
- The person who leads the services at a synagogue is called a rabbi.
- During a service, Jews read from the Torah, sing songs and pray to God.

Symbols

- The symbol most associated with Judaism is the Star of David. David was a king of Israel.



Beliefs

- Jews believe in one God who created the whole universe.
- Jews believe everyone can have a personal relationship with God.
- Jews follow the Ten Commandments that were given to Moses by God on Mount Sinai, as well as other rules in the Torah.
- Jews believe some foods, such as pork, should not be eaten. Foods that are safe to eat are known as kosher foods.
- Jews believe that one day a week should be a day of rest. This day is known as the Sabbath or Shabbat.
