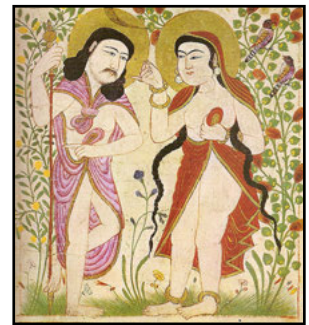


## The Prophets of Islam.

There are twenty-five prophets mentioned in the Qur'an. The Qur'an is the Muslim holy book. Muslims believe that prophets give guidance and instructions about how to behave and worship. Prophets are people who share God's instructions.



Many religions believe **Adam** was the first human created. In the Qur'an Adam was made from clay and is the father of humans. God teaches him to name the animals.



**Noah** (Nuh) is an important figure in Islam. The Qur'an says that people mocked him because he wasn't an angel. Some people even called him a devil. So God created the flood to get rid of all the sinners.

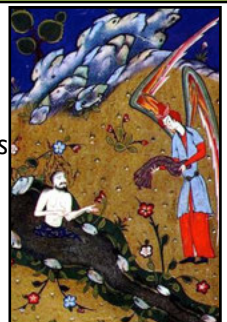


**Abraham** (Ibrahim) is the second most mentioned prophet in the Qur'an. Islamic traditions say God tested his faith often during his life, but Abraham stayed true to God. He was ready to sacrifice his son if God asked him to.

**Ishmael** (Isma'il) was the first son of Abraham. The Qur'an says Ishmael and his mother, Hagar, discovered a spring in the desert. The city of Mecca grew around this spring. Mecca is a place of pilgrimage for Muslims.



In the Qur'an **Job** (Ayoub) is a rich and healthy man. He regularly prays to thank God for his blessings. Satan inflicts illness and suffering on him to test him. When he stays true to God, God returns his health and riches.

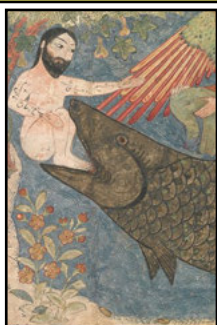


**Moses** (Musa) is mentioned more than anyone else in the Qur'an. He is said to be a prophet and a messenger because he gave God's message to his people. Moses freed the Israelites from the Egyptian pharaoh.

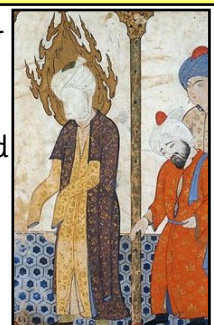


Some Islamic legends say that **Elijah** (Elias) was half-human and half-angel. He told people to worship God and to stop worshipping idols.

**Jonah** (Younis) was faithful to God, but one day he fled. He got on a boat but was thrown into the sea. Despite being eaten by a fish he kept praying to God. The fish spat him out and he continued to preach God's message.



**Muhammad** was the founder of Islam. Muslims believe the Qur'an was revealed to him. Islam began when Muhammad went to Medina and people began to follow his message. Muslims say 'Peace be upon him' after saying his name.
