


Identity and Belonging

Learning Objective: To consider the ways in which we express our identity.








How do you express your identity?






How do they behave? What do they wear? How do they relate to other people?

Many people express their religious identity through worship.



They may take time to pray or meditate every day. Many Muslims pray at five different times during the day.

They may go to a place of worship to pray, sing or study religious books with others.












Christians may wear a cross or a crucifix.



Jewish boys and men may wear a Kippah, or Yarmulke when they pray; some Jewish men wear them all the time.

Some Muslim men may not trim their beards, and some Sikh men and women do not cut their hair. Sikhs may wear a turban to wrap up



their long hair and keep it clean. They do these things because of religious rules and teachings, and as a reminder of their commitment to their beliefs.
