Today you are going to write an information text about the animal/creature that you have discovered!

You will need to use your plan to help support the structure and language choice.

One main skill to focus on will be varying your sentences (to make it engaging for the reader) and including interesting openers.

*Adverbial openers* are a great way to engage the reader; it can be used to vary your sentence structure.

*Amazingly, Rhiswanozebtahs like to burrow and, therefore, make their homes underground.*

You can also use these to start your sentence:

Interestingly, Surprisingly, Weirdly, Intriguingly, Unusually, Astoundingly,

Additional things to remember:

- Interesting, descriptive language
- Paragraphs to structure your writing (appearance, habitat etc.)
- Third person
- Rhetorical question
- Pictures to support your text
