Can you find items that measure the same as the following measurements?

Take a picture, if you can, next to a ruler and make a pic collage, draw the objects to scale and show measurements, record in a table or find another creative way of showing your results.

32mm	5mm
456mm	308mm
8cm	19cm
124mm	38cm
56cm	105cm
0.8m	0.67m
1.45m	1.96m

Also remember if you are growing sunflowers or beans you can measure these or any other plants you may have
