Today we are moving on to learn about length.

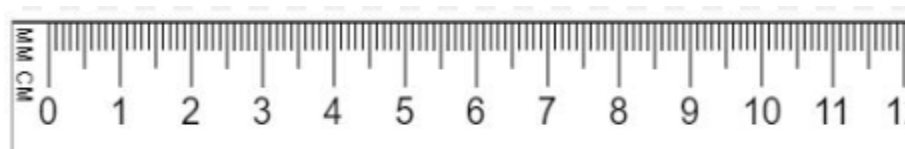
What is the length?

Why is it important to start measuring from 0 on the ruler?



Today's challenge:



If you have a ruler or tape measure at home measure at least 10 different objects in your house in cm and write them down. Then order them from smallest to biggest.

If you do not have a ruler or tape measure at home you could use non-standard units- how many paper clips long? How many fingers long? How many pen lids long? Etc

After you have measured do the same as above and order your objects from smallest to biggest.

This pencil is 4 paper clips long.
