Dear Parents and Carers.

Last week we welcomed back some of our Year 1 children and this week Reception groups also joined our partial re-opening. All of the children settled really well and have adapted to our Covid-Secure school quickly. Our groups for key worker and vulnerable children are now full and we currently have roughly 30% of our children accessing in-school provision. I am looking closely at how I could potentially extend this provision for the final two weeks of term as I do have some staff able to return to the school environment in the coming weeks.

I will be writing to you next Friday with details of class organisation and teachers for the new academic year. The teachers are putting together video messages for the children so links to those will be included in the letters I send. I am hoping to be able to finalise the arrangements for our socially distanced picnics between 20<sup>th</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> July in the same letters.

I have been asked by the RNLI to remind families of water safety around our beaches across the summer season. This is their advice: Without you by their side, children are vulnerable at the beach. They need you to protect them from the sea's unpredictable waves, rip currents and cold water. And, this summer, fewer lifeguard patrols will be on hand to supervise or rescue your family. Don't use inflatables - they get swept out to sea, with you or your child on them. And watch out for rip currents. Here's how to spot them and get out of them. Every beach is different, so make a point of reading any safety signs. What if you get in to danger? If you have your mobile phone, call 999 and ask for the Coastguard, and they will send help. Leave difficult rescues to the lifesavers. If there are lifeguards nearby, alert them. If you or your children are struggling in the water, remember: FLOAT TO LIVE. Finally, I also do need to take this opportunity to ask for your cooperation on an important matter:

One of our pupils is receiving medical treatment for cancer which puts them at risk if they are exposed to measles, chicken pox or shingles. The best way to protect our pupil from measles is for all children at school to be immunized against measles. Please would you discuss measles immunisation with your GP if your child has not received it. If your child is suspected of having measles, you should let us know immediately.

Our pupil is also at risk from chicken pox and would need to be given an injection within three days of contact. If your child is suspected of having chicken pox you should let us know immediately. It is also important that you let us know if there is shingles in your household.

Your child is not at risk whatsoever from this situation. However, the health and well-being of our pupil who is at risk, does depend on the co-operation of all other parents and we hope you can help us.
