I write with exciting news regarding the new academic year.

Overleaf, I have detailed new class teachers and class movement. For Years 4 and 5 I have also sent learning group changes. Mrs Hughes brings a wealth of experience with her and we warmly welcome her to her new role. She has already joined the Viking team and will be gradually introducing herself to families over the course of this term. Mrs Whitworth (who from September will revert to being known as Miss Cheshire) has also now formally taken on the role of Assistant Headteacher and maintains her teaching commitment and leadership of Reception and Year 1. Finally, I have appointed a new Deputy Headteacher. Miss Natalie Barrow joins us from September but will be visiting the school prior to this – notably for our transition morning and open evening.

All of our new appointments truly add strength and valuable experience to Team Chilton. I am delighted to be in a position to welcome such excellent practitioners to the school and I know that they are extremely excited to join us in providing the best possible school experience for all of our pupils.
