
I wish you all a wonderful summer holiday with your children. Let the sun shine and allow us to enjoy six weeks of fun, friendship and laughter!

Academic Achievement.....

In the grand scheme of things, SATs results are not the focus and purpose of our daily life at Chilton. However, they are important in judging a school's performance and the quality of education that it provides....

I am extremely proud to share our Year 6 results. They exceeded national average standards and county expectations and they are the highest that they have been in some years – and this is from the new, much tougher curriculum and test standards. They are a testament to our fabulous pupils but also to the talented and dedicated staff who have all played a part in this success – Team Chilton!
