Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you are all keeping well and managing everything as best as you can. This world of remote and in school learning is difficult to navigate and we know how hard it is to sustain. The one thing we absolutely do not want to do is cause more stress to you or your children. We are all in this together and we must just keep trying to do the best that we can within our very varied circumstances and challenges.

Please do get in touch if we can do anything to support you in accessing the live and recorded sessions that we are providing via Teams. This remote teaching does not replicate what can happen in the classroom but it does give children access to their teachers and some social interaction with their peers. I encourage you to create a routine for home learning that works for you and your family and I also stress the importance of continuing with regular reading above all else. Taking regular screen breaks and movement breaks is also really important.

I do need to place some boundaries around the use of Teams. With families rightly accessing the learning within their own routine, Teams does provide a never ending stream of workload for teachers through messages and tasks being submitted at different times. The system does work best if assignments are completed on the days that they are set rather than trying to catch up if you get behind with submitting the tasks. Teachers will now only be giving feedback on individual assignments if they are submitted on the days they are set. Verbal feedback will continue to be given in live lessons. Teachers will be responding to messages and emails between the hours of 8:30 and 4:30. I hope you can appreciate that we continue to try to find ways to work that are manageable for all concerned.

I have no inside knowledge or information on when schools will reopen. I know as much as the government and DFE are willing to communicate through the media on a day to day basis. We have been told that we will be given two weeks notice for the reopening of schools, whether that be a partial opening such as that in Term 6 or a full reopening at some point in term 4. We will continue to do all that we can in this time to offer the best possible remote teaching and learning whilst also preparing for a successful and safe return to school once again. We want the school open again and we want the children back in their classrooms learning with us and their friends.

On a completely different note, I am absolutely thrilled to tell you that Miss Barrow had a baby boy during the Christmas holidays – Seth Gabriel Russell. Both mother and baby are doing well! Miss Barrow is now on maternity leave and Mrs Cheshire has stepped up in to an Acting Deputy Head role.

With one more week of January left, daylight hours are creeping up minute by minute and eventually, days will be brighter and warmer. This time will pass and we will get through it. Things will be better.

We are still here for you – at school, on the phone or at the end of an email. We miss you and hope to see you as soon as possible!
