Dear Parents and Carers,

We've enjoyed a fantastic Number Day today in aid of the NSPCC. Thank you to all of our families for your support for this event and for the children's amazing costumes! The children took part in a range of mathematical activities and there was a Mastermind times tables competition which included teachers testing their skills. My thanks to Miss Lane for organising a fantastic day.



Next Friday (14th May) is a non-uniform day for **ROMANS as their reward for winning the House Points competition. A new six week competition is now underway.**

I wanted to make you aware of our plans to slowly and cautiously begin to take steps to 'unlock' Chilton as the country continues to do the same. At the moment, children are still playing within bubble spaces outdoors, although we have now removed the tape and most markers as the children know their areas and they do stick to them. Without the physical dividers in place, play spaces have a greater sense of freedom and gives a sense of progress away from restrictions. From 17th May, the plan is for children to be able to move in to year group play areas again – being able to move throughout that space with other children in their year group. After half term, we will gradually allow greater mixing outdoors until we hope to be back to 'normal' playgrounds and field.

From 17th May, there will also be some mixing indoors between Reception classes and also between Year 1 classes for some of their phonics groups. This allows us to group the children more appropriately for their next steps in learning – so that we can match support and challenge carefully to the children's needs.

I will keep you updated as and when we take any further steps to unlock. I continue to be extremely cautious and plan to take things slowly along the way.

Further plans for Sports Days and end of year events for Year 6 are under construction and we hope to be in the position to confirm these with you early in Term 6 to give as much notice as possible.
