Dear Viking Parents/Carers

**'Back to School 2021'** is undeniably a time of mixed emotions. Staff across the Viking Academy Trust are looking forward with enthusiasm to the start of a brand-new school year. Children and families the length and breadth of the country will be preparing for the re-opening of school gates; with back to school routines happening in every home.

We had hoped the new academic year would allow us the freedom to move forward, away from the constraints and restraints Covid-19 has brought with it. It many ways, the reopening of our schools will be a return to 'familiar routine' however, unfortunately, with positive cases of the coronavirus still high in our community\*, particularly so among young people – we must remain vigilant in our health and safety procedures and proceed with caution. Covid-19 hasn't gone away; friends and family are still testing positive for the virus and sadly, some people are becoming very poorly indeed.

The government has made it very clear the education of our children cannot suffer the disruption it has across the last two academic years. Quite rightly, Viking school leaders will do everything they can to ensure children return to a safe, settled and calm environment - however, we cannot remove all risk – only look to manage the risk in the best way we can to keep our children, staff and community as safe as possible.

Viking staff will continue to take lateral flow tests (LFTs) twice weekly having tested prior to their return to school for the start of the new school year. If possible, I ask if families would also consider taking a lateral flow test before the children return to their new class.

My priority across the initial days of this new academic year will be to ensure communication systems are strong and everyone at Viking feels they have a voice – to speak out, be heard and most importantly, listened to.
