Dear Parents and Carers,

As you may be aware, when the children enter into year one, the behaviour system changes slightly for them. Their teachers have explained the changes to them in class and we have detailed the changes for you below.

Every child begins the week with 25 points (5 points per day). Points are lost for poor behaviour choices after a clear system of warnings. A yellow card loses one point and a red card loses two. Every time one of these cards is placed on a child's table, however, it can be removed again if the child changes the behaviour and points are thereby kept.

In order to adapt this for the youngest pupils in our school we will have a behaviour chart in class with the children's names down the left hand side with 25 dots next to their names. The columns will be colour coded. Therefore if the child has kept all their points they will still have their dot in the green column. 24 and 23 points will be indicated by amber columns and 22 and below with red columns.

The behaviour system is focused on recognising and rewarding children <u>always</u> doing the right thing. For children keeping all 25 points, there are weekly and cumulative rewards. There is also a whole class incentive which gains stars, adding up to whole class reward activities (ice-cream or movie afternoons etc.) Should your child gain a red card their class teacher will inform you as to why this has happened. You will receive a text message at the end of the week if your child has kept all their points.
