Dear Parents and Carers,

This term seems to be flying by already and with four weeks until half term, we have some events at school to make you aware of.

From Monday 24<sup>th</sup> January - Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> January, we will be welcoming the Scholastic Book Fair back to Chilton Primary School. In the morning from 8.20am, the Book Fair will be outside of the Year 5 classrooms (the area at the bottom of the slope to the field). After school, the Book Fair will be placed on the Key Stage 1 playground from 2.50pm. There will be a range of books suitable for all year groups available and every book we sell generate funds that the school can then spend on books. We look forward to seeing you there!

I am pleased to be able to inform you that a new Road Crossing Patrol (Tara) has successfully been appointed and we are expecting her to start on the 24<sup>th</sup> January. I know that the lack of crossing patrol has been frustrating and I am sure all of our families will welcome the return of the service.

#### NSPCC Number Day

Number Day is back on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> February! The children will have a fun-filled day of maths activities and games whilst raising money for the NSPCC. The children are invited to dress up in number themed clothing, as a Times Table Rockstar or as a Maths Superhero for a voluntary donation.

Throughout the day the children will be challenged and engaged with Maths. One of the lessons will be related to a fiction text that has mathematical themes. This will be used to support the children's learning and will be based on the skill they are focusing on that week as part of their maths lessons. There will also be a Times Table Rockstar competition the week beginning the 31<sup>st</sup> January. The winners of this competition will be announced on Number Day where prizes will be awarded to the top three classes who scored highest.



#### Healthy Relationships Week & Children's Mental Health Week – 7<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> Feb

Our next Healthy Relationships focused week will be 7<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> February and will be focused on online safety. Safer Internet Day falls during the week on the 8<sup>th</sup> February. This week also coincides with Children's Mental Health Week and so as part of our Healthy Relationships learning, we will be taking part in a 'Dress to Express' awareness event on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> February which is being organised by the mental health charity Place2Be. On the day, we invite all the children to come to school expressing themselves, by wearing bright colours. During the day the children will be exploring self-compassion; understanding what things they do that boost their wellbeing and sharing this with others. We have John Lake, a children's mentor for Charlton Athletic Community Trust' joining us for the day to run wellbeing workshops with the children.

## **Changes to Covid Testing Requirements:**

From 11<sup>th</sup> January, if you receive a positive lateral flow test result and you are asymptomatic, you are no longer required to confirm the result with a follow up PCR test. You must observe the isolation requirements (10 days or 7 days after a negative test on day 6 and day 7). If you do have Covid symptoms, you are required to obtain a PCR test.

Whilst you don't have to follow up with PCR if asymptomatic - if a family want to claim the Test and Trace Support payment - then they do need the PCR test result. Please click here for that guidance:
