Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you have all had a wonderful Easter. Welcome back to Term 5 which promises to pass by in a flash! Now that we are in the summer terms, I would like to remind families of our uniform policy. Uniform is in place not only for health and safety reasons but also to keep things fair for all.

Our uniform consists of:

- Grey skirt / pinafore / shorts or trousers
- White shirt or polo shirt
- Light blue gingham summer dresses
- White, black or grey socks
- Black school shoes (not sandals)
- Navy blue jumper or cardigan

Hair longer than shoulder length should be tied back and the only jewellery permitted is a wrist-watch and small stud earrings. Hoodies should not be worn as a school jumper apart from those provided by the school. Trainers should only be worn on Sports Project Days.

Our PE kit consists of:

- White t-shirt
- Navy blue or black shorts or track-suit bottoms
- Navy blue or black sweatshirts / track-suit top
- Trainers or plimsolls

As the weather does warm up and the sun becomes stronger, we also recommend that children bring a sun-hat to school and have sun-cream applied before school. We cannot apply sun-cream to children but if children bring their own in, they can apply it themselves during the day. Please also make sure the children have a water-bottle in school with them! Many thanks for your understanding.

Without wishing to tempt fate, currently we have very low rates of Covid affecting our school community – long may this continue for once! The guidelines for children testing positive for Covid are:

- If children test positive and feel unwell, they should stay at home for three days
- If children test positive and have a temperature, they should remain at home until the temperature has subsided without the use of medication (Calpol etc.)

There are also a couple of key dates to make you aware of for this term:

- Class photos are being taken on Monday 23rd May
- We are holding a red, white and blue day on the 26th May in celebration of the Jubilee. There will be a special themed lunch and children are invited to come to school in red, white and blue clothes
- Our celebration parade for our Be Here, Be You, Belong PSHE project will be on Friday 27th May at 2:15 on the school field and parents are warmly welcomed to attend.
