Dear Parents and Carers,

This week has been Year 6 SATs week and I wanted to mention in the newsletter how phenomenal the children have been throughout. We haven't had SATs tests for three years and our Year 6 children and teachers were cool, calm and collected. They did their best and did themselves and us proud! They now get to enjoy their final stretch with us at Chilton.

In the last week of term, we have two special event days. On Thursday 26th May, the kitchen are preparing special Jubilee themed menu and so the children are invited to come in to school wearing red, white and blue clothes in celebration.

On Friday 27th May (the final day of term) we are holding our celebration event for our 'Be Here, Be You, Belong' project. This will be an informal event on the Key Stage Two playground where children will parade and show off some of their learning. We will start at 2:15 and parents are welcome to attend. If we could ask you to stand around the edges of the playground as this will be our staging area! We should be finished by 3:00 and then children will be dismissed from their classroom as usual so if you could allow them to leave the playground first to go back inside and get organised for home time, we would be grateful. We are hopeful that the weather is kind but if it does decide to rain, we will have to cancel unfortunately.

Further ahead, we have some important confirmed dates for Term 6. Our summer fair will be held straight after school from 3:15 until 5:00 on Friday 24th June. We will be having our traditional tombola stall at the fair and so will be holding a non-uniform day on 17th June in exchange for a donation of a bottle of something for the tombola.

Wednesday 13th July at 9:15 will be Key Stage Two (Year 3-6) Sports Day. This usually lasts until 11:30. Reception will have their Sports Day on the afternoon of Wednesday 13th July starting at 1:45. Thursday 14th July at 9:15 will be Sports Day for Key Stage One (Years 1 and 2) and this should finish by 10:45. Parents are warmly welcomed to attend these events on the school field. Full details will come out to you early next term.

In terms of meeting teachers for the new academic year, we will hold three transition days for the children to spend time in their new classes with new teachers right at the end of term (Monday 18th to Wednesday 20th). Having proper time for teachers to get to know children before September has huge benefits and the three days right at the end of term will mean that children will have a good understanding of what will happen in September. New teachers have not been completely finalised yet and again, I will communicate this with you when all is in place after half-term!

I have had a couple of questions about the last day of this academic year before the summer holidays and so wanted to confirm that our last day of the year is Thursday 21st July. Year 6 will finish at 1:30 and the rest of the school at 2:00.
