Dear Parents and Carers,

We are now entering the final three weeks of this academic year and there is still a lot going on at Chilton. The end of term is full of activities and below I have outlined some important information about what's ahead involving the whole school. Please do keep an eye on blogs for other class and year group specific information.

Sports Days – a separate letter has been emailed along with the newsletter outlining the details for our three Sports Days (Year 3-6 morning of 13th July, Reception afternoon of 13th July and Years 1 and 2 morning of 14th July).

On **Friday 15th July** we will have an **inflatable fun day** where every class will get to enjoy the inflatables that we have hired as a treat for their fantastic behaviour and learning all year. This day will be a non-uniform day for the whole school. Please could we ask that children still wear appropriate clothing for school and definitely do not wear flip-flops (the potential for injury from running around in flip-flops is high!).

Transition Days – Monday 18th July to Wednesday 20th July: On Monday 18th, the children should come in to school and go to their current classrooms. After an assembly, they will then go to their new classrooms with new teachers where they will spend the next three days. This means that children will need to be collected from and dropped off to their new classrooms from the afternoon of Monday 18th to Wednesday 20th. On Thursday 21st (our last day), everything will revert back to normal and the children will spend their final day with their current teachers. We will make sure that new classrooms are well sign-posted and staff will be on hand to direct you! Year 6 children will need to register and be collected from the field between the afternoons of Monday 18th and Wednesday 20th.

Final Day of Term: On our final day of term, we will be giving our Year 6 children a special send off. They will be ready to leave the school site at 1:30pm and may have some special arrangements to take them away from school. For this reason, we do ask parents to avoid driving along and parking in Chilton Lane until after 1:45. Experience tells us that congestion can be a problem and we do want to get our Year 6 children away safely and in style. The rest of the school finishes the day at 2:00pm on Thursday 21st July.

On the subject of leavers, it is time to share the news of those people leaving Chilton's shores at the end of term. Miss Barrow, one of our Deputy Heads, has secured a new post working as a Deputy Head across another multi-academy trust which is closer to her home. I won't be replacing Miss Barrow (I don't believe that I could!) and so Mrs Cheshire becomes my sole Deputy Head and we will be supported by newly appointed Key Stage Leaders. For KS1, Miss Davey takes the helm and for KS2 it will be Mrs Gale.

As I mentioned in the last newsletter, Miss Howell is leaving us to take a new teaching opportunity in London.

We also say goodbye to Mrs Smith, one of our Teaching Assistants, who has been with us at Chilton for over twenty years! Mrs Smith has taken the decision to retire after all these years of service.

Also leaving us in July will be Miss Dowling, Mrs Williams and Miss Stow, also members of our Teaching Assistant team.

I know you will join me in wishing them all the best in their future endeavours!
