Dear Parents and Carers,

It is that time again... SPORTS DAY! To celebrate the Commonwealth Games 2022, our Celebration of Sport will take place over two days on the Key Stage Two playground and field:

Wednesday 13th July – Key Stage 2 (Years 3-6) from 09:15

– Reception from 13:30

Thursday 14th July – Key Stage 1 (Years 1-2) from 09:15

Children will be encouraged to wear brightly coloured sports-wear (any colour) or their normal PE kit which they will come to school in and wear all day. We do ask that this be suitable for school and the activities they will be completing so please can we ask that children do not wear football shirts or cropped tops.

We do lack shade on the field and at the moment, the long-range forecast is for hot weather so children will need water bottles, a hat and will need to wear sun-screen.

The school day will start as usual and then children will make their way with their classes to the field for 9:15. Feel free to cheer as the classes are announced! Children will stay with their classes and will take part in a carousel of activities, applying the skills they have learnt this year in their PE lessons to the competition for their House Teams. They will move through each numbered event in order. A map will be available on the day. At the end of the carousel of activities, children will congregate in their classes in sections on the field. There will then be an opportunity for sprinting races for each year group. Spectators will be welcome to assemble on the edge of the field to watch and cheer. This year, we would like to continue our Leavers' Race where children in Year Six will participate in a fun Chilton Challenge, consisting of an assault course – they will each need a towel and a change of clothing (but that's a secret) We also hope to bring back Mums', Dads' and Toddlers' races (although all are welcome to join in).

We will then move over to the playground where awards will be given. This year, staff will be looking out for children who have demonstrated the School Games values (Self-Belief, Determination, Honesty, Team Work, Passion and Respect) and special awards will be given out to those children who have demonstrated them. The Sports Day Cup will also be awarded to the winning House after which the children will head off back to class. We anticipate the morning events for KS1 and 2 finishing by 11:30am and Reception by 2:30pm.

We hope you can join us in celebrating our year of sport and thank you for your continued support.
