Children should come to school in their PE kits on the day with a t-shirt in their house colour if possible, with trainers. If the weather is hot, children should bring a hat, wear sun cream and have a water bottle with them. If it turns out to be a chilly day, jogging bottoms and a jumper will be needed! Children in Years 3 – 6 will also need a packed lunch as they will be having a picnic. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals, a lunch will be provided.

Reception and KS1 children should come to school at normal time. KS2 children are asked to be in school at 8:30am on the day of their competition as they will be travelling to Upton. They should be collected from Chilton at normal time.

Green	Team Gemili	Adam Gemili is the 2014 200m and 4x100m relay European Champion and 2017 4x100m relay World Champion.
Blue	Team Belt	Megan Belt is a Kent cricketer from Margate. She has won the County Championship four times and the leading wicket-taker in 2013 Twenty20 Cup.
