Margate Mosque Visit – Monday 9th February 2026 (packed lunch needed)

As part of the Year 6's Religious Education learning, they will visit the Margate Mosque. The children will travel to Margate by train (Ramsgate to Margate) and then walk to the mosque. The children will need a packed lunch, a drink and a coat to wear. The children will return to school after lunch. Please let the school office know if you would like the school to provide a lunch for your child.

The London Eye and Thames River Cruise – Friday 15th May 2026 (packed lunch and snacks needed)

We will travel by train, leaving at 9:00am by train (Ramsgate Train Station). The children will visit the London Eye followed by a river cruise. Children will need to be in school uniform with comfortable shoes and will need to bring a packed lunch, snacks and plenty to drink. We will depart London at approx. 5pm and hope to be back at school between 7:15-7:30pm – we will keep you updated with our progress. The children will not need spending money and all mobile phones will be kept at school in a secure area in the school office. Children will need to be collected from the Chilton carpark at approx. 7:15pm.

Betteshanger – Boonies – Tuesday 2nd June 2026 (packed lunch needed)

The children will take part in an adventure course. Children will need to wear clothing suitable for adventure course activities and will need to wear trainers that they are happy to get very wet and muddy.
