What you need to book your child a place:

Please complete the booking onto club form with [CONSENTS HERE](#)

- Once form completed, you will receive an MCAS message letting you know that you can now book on MCAS (please allow 2 working days for this process)
- Log into your MCAS (MyChildatSchool) account
- Go to 'wraparound care'
- Choose available wraparound care and select Viking Holiday Club
- Enrol to club
- Go to enrolled wraparound care and re-select Viking Holiday Club
- Book your preferred sessions – the default is weekday £20 which applies to all days this time

If you need to book a sibling who attends the school – select *Sibling Weekday* from their account once you have booked the first sibling.

Points to note:

- If you are planning to use **tax free credit/childcare vouchers** to pay, complete the consent form first and then please contact ar@vikingacademytrust.com with full name of your child, the name of the school they attend and the days that you require – **Do not book on MCAS, the finance team will do this for you.**
- **Upton families** – if you are wishing to book a younger sibling who is in Year R, 1 or 2 at another school, complete the consent form first and then contact ar@vikingacademytrust.com and provide their full name, date of birth, the name of their sibling at Upton and the dates you require. **Do not book on MCAS, the finance team will do this for you.**

Please book and pay on MCAS by Thursday 12th February

Viking staff supervisors Miss Arthur (Upton) and Mr Noble (Upton) lead Holiday Club, with additional staff from our Viking schools working to support them.

Children will need to come dressed in suitable clothing (including wet weather) for outdoor and indoor activities.

Please DO NOT bring toys and valuables from home.
