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Dear Year 6 Families,

I am writing with full details of dates for our Year 6 children. This letter is very detailed and includes information about the Year 6 activities planned.

- **Tuesday 5th May – Thursday 14th May - We will be running a free special Year 6 breakfast club.** We invite all the children to attend this, free of charge, from 8:00 each morning. The club will be held in the Year 6 classrooms and will offer both hot and cold breakfast options along with fruit, drinks and snacks. Children are warmly welcomed to attend to settle in for a busy period in their schooling and to feel relaxed and ready for the tests.
- **Tuesday 11th May – Thursday 14th May** – Year 6 SATS every day.
- **Friday 15th May 2026 - The London Eye and Thames River Cruise – (packed lunch and snacks needed)** We will travel by train, leaving at 9:00am by train (Ramsgate Train Station). The children will visit the London Eye followed by a river cruise. Children will need to be in school uniform with comfortable shoes and will need to bring a packed lunch, snacks and plenty to drink. We will depart London at approx. 5pm and hope to be back at school between 7:15-7:30pm – we will keep you updated with our progress. The children will not need spending money and all mobile phones will be kept at school in a secure area in the school office. Children will need to be collected from the Chilton car park at approx. 7:15pm.
- **Monday 18th May** – Year 5/6 Viking Games at Upton. Children to come to school in PE kit.
- **Friday 22nd May** – Dress to impress day. A parade will take place on the school field at 2pm and families are invited to attend.

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- **Wednesday 24th June – Year 6 Assembly** – families invited to watch.
- **Tuesday 30th June – Chilton Music Evening 6pm**
- **Wednesday 1st, Thursday 2nd and Friday 3rd July** – Year 6 Secondary School transition days (please check with schools for individual arrangements).
- **Friday 3rd July** – Chilton Summer Fayre 3:30pm
- **Tuesday 7th July and Wednesday 8th July** – Year 6 Production 6pm. More information and this production and ticket sales will follow in Term 6.
- **Friday 10th July** - Stage Two Sports Day – 9am – 11:45 approx.
- **Friday 10th July** – Year 6 to receive their school reports
- **Monday 13th, Tuesday 14th and Wednesday 15th July** – Transition Project with our Sports Team. Children can come to school in their own sportswear for these three days.
- **Thursday 16th July – Year 6 Shirt signing day and the Year 6 Leavers’ Inflatable Fun Party on the school field – 3:30 – 6:00** (children will need to bring a change of clothes with them for the party. Children should be collected at 6:00 from the school field.
