Our school residential to Carroty Wood is fast approaching and we wanted to get in touch with some final reminders of everything our families need to know to be fully prepared for the trip.

- As you are all aware the trip will run from Monday 14th September to Thursday 17th September. **The children will need to arrive and be collected at the usual times on these days.**
- Children will need to bring a **packed lunch with them for the Monday**, but no other food/drink needs to be provided for the week.
- On Monday 14th September any **medication required for the trip needs to be handed over to Miss Knight who will be sat outside the year 6 classrooms that morning** at drop off. It is **imperative** that all medication (**including asthma pumps**) is handed in to Miss Knight and not left in the children's bags.
- We ask that children who require travel sickness tablets take those before/upon arrival at school with a parent present on Monday 14th September. Staff will administer these on Thursday 17th September before we return.
- **No phones or hand-held games** are permitted, and children do not need to bring any pocket money.

Below is a list of the items the children will need to bring. All daytime clothing should be suitable for outdoor, physical activities. Please note clothes are likely to get wet and mucky!

- T-shirts and jumpers/fleece – layers!
- Jeans as well as jogging trousers. Jogging trousers must be worn for raft building
- At least 2 pairs of trainers – one for outdoor and one for indoor (clogs not allowed for activities)
- Wellies or boots
- Waterproof coat
- Lots of socks
- Hat, gloves etc
- Change of clothes for evening – nothing too smart!
- Hair ties
- Towel x 2 (one for showering and one for drying off after water activities which may get muddy)
- Swimming shorts/costumes
- A few empty black sacks to put wet clothing in to
- Toiletries
- Torch
- Water bottle
- Backpack to use as hand luggage
- Book or notepad with a pen/pencil

The children will begin their activities after lunch on the Monday, so please ensure what they wear to school on Monday is appropriate for activities (trainers, comfortable clothes that they may get dirty, layers).
