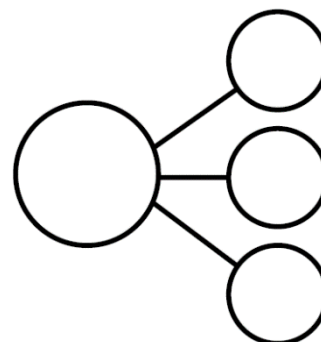
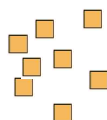
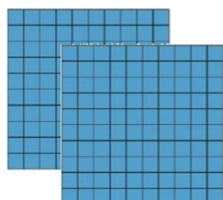
Remember: 10 ones = 1 ten and 10 tens = 1 hundred.

 I could regroup *the number as 2 hundreds, 2 tens and 15 ones.*

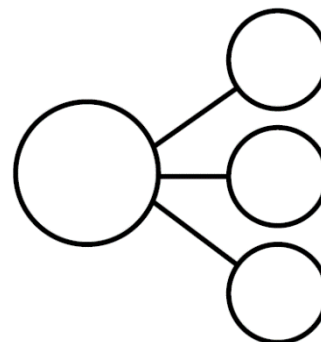
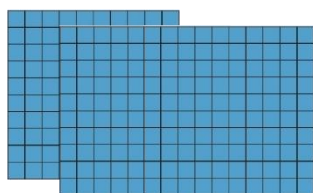
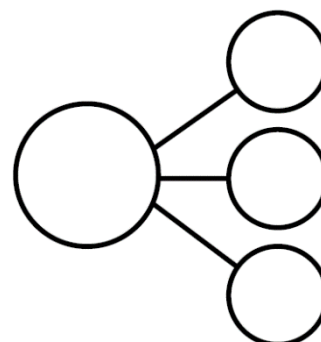
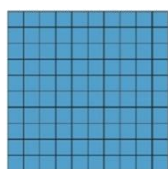
